He/She controls the work of the Texas Senate, as president, controls the budgeting process as a leader of the Legislative Budget Board. The Lt. Governor establishes all special and standing committees, appoints all chairpersons and members, and assigns all Senate legislation to the committee of his choice. He/She is an ex officio member of several statutory bodies including the Legislative Budget Board, the Legislative Council, the Legislative Audit Committee, the Legislative Board and Legislative Council, the budget and policy and is also a member of the Legislative Redistricting Board, charged with adopting a redistricting plan for the TX House and Senate, or U.S. House after the decennial census if the Legislature fails to do so. Mike, a graduate of the UT, worked for Exxon briefly but most of his career was spent with PricewaterhouseCoopers (PwC) an accounting firm, as an auditor. In Houston, he lead a team of two dozen providing financial services to some of PwC's largest energy companies. The experience serves as a solid baseline for understanding the duties and policies of the Texas Lieutenant Governor.

- ✓ **Property tax reform:** Close the property tax loopholes. Use the recovered funds to fund education and reduce property tax for homeowners and small businesses. (Dan Patrick's four annual budgets called for property values and local taxes "shall be increased" by 4.56 percent in 2015, 6.18 percent in 2016, 7.04 percent in 2017, and 6.77 percent in 2018 or 26.9 percent since Dan Patrick took office.)

- √ Implemented much of the women's health care for the U.S. Military in the European Theatre

- √ Partnered with the UT Medical School to determine why the mortality rate for men and women of color who have breast cancer is significantly greater than for white women and to look for treatments which give better outcomes.
- √ Co-founded (with UT Medical School) the African American Breast Cancer Awareness and administers a \$5 Million grant for finding solutions for people with cancer.
