## EDITORIAL

### “We Hold these Rights to be Self Evident.”

#### Amendment I

Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances. *The U.S. Constitution, The Bill of Rights: Amendment 1*

Plain and simple words guarantying our most basic and precious rights — nicknamed the “Free Speech Amendment.” Each of us have the right to speak, print, peaceably gather and express our complaints. A key thought here is: “each.” I have this right and it extends only so far as me. It stops when another person starts with their individual place. Each of us are equal, under the law, but separate. Indeed, we gather in like minded groups, homogeneous and collectively, governed by many laws of this great land. We cannot kill another person for many reasons, but our individual rights do not permit any one of us to invade the personhood of another.

George Washington, a man of great personal integrity, chose to be a citizen rather than a monarch. He crystallized the power of the presidency as a part of the government’s three balanced branches of power. The current hate group, the ALT-Right consisting of terrorists screaming openly about white supremacy, perpetrating mayhem and violence are no longer hiding behind the hooded costumes. The rage reaches all the way to the White House and the presidency. Yes, free speech and the redress of grievances are guaranteed rights. As is peaceable assembly a right. Prevarication (lying), threats, bullying, violence are simply against the rule of law, our Constitution.

### Freedom or Folly?

A nation which denies me the freedom of my space has lost its moral compass.

Let's get real! The Bill of Rights has legal limitations. Freedom does not include the legitimization of the destruction of our social order. My hospitality to you does not include your right to burn down my house. Likewise, citizenship does not include the right to subvert the social framework of our country. Our country is about building "a more perfect union" and "insuring domestic tranquility." Suggesting that our Framers envisioned and our warriors have died in defense of a nation, a nation which sees freedom to include engaging is a tyranny, we waged war against at least three times in our nation's history, is a travesty. Freedom of speech or assembly is not license to engage in subversion of the Constitution or intimidating others.

We seem to be at loggerheads these days because we have confused the right to exchange ideas in print or in the public arena with acts of hooliganism and intimidation. We tolerate anti-abortion groups blocking access to Planned Parenthood clinics, as though one women's freedom of speech includes denying other women their constitutional right. The public square is the public's space and no one should be allowed to make anyone else feel threatened or alienate in it. Torch-lite marches are not an exercise of freedom of speech; it is society foolishly looking the other way when the Constitution is being subverted.

When law enforcement thinks it is necessary to station its personnel in an area where "freedom of speech" is being enjoyed, there is some crazy thinking going on. People showing up at a public assembly carrying long guns, are not there to engage in a discussion of the fine points of the law. Waving a Confederate battle flag or Nazi banner does not suggest they are there to debate slavery or the rise and fall of the Third Reich. A freedom, only protected if practiced within one's personal property, is no freedom at all! Law enforcement is there to protect the threatened from attackers, not oversee the process and bandage up the survivors.

People peaceably gathering in a public area, should not have to fear for their physical safety. A society what espouses "freedom of speech" for a "peaceful assemblage," but then assumes others, under that same "freedom of speech," have a legal right to disrupt that assemblage by violence, is a society disconnected from reality. The message going out right now is that if I sit down on a park bench to have a chat with a friend, a Nazi sympathizer, with his long gun slung over his shoulder, has a right to sit down beside me and demand my attention. That's nonsense.

A nation which denies me the freedom of my space has lost its moral compass. Coercion of others, regardless of how subtle, is not an exercise of any freedom worth defending.

Rabbi Andrew Paley of Temple Shalom and Faith Forward Dallas:

Remarks from the Dallas Rally against White Supremacy. Rabbi Paley was honored to have been one of the speakers to bring a message of love and hope.

“My friends...what an awesome sight to see so many people who are here tonight standing on the side of caring and kindness, of unity of belief that no one is supreme over anyone else.

There is a beautiful teaching that reminds us that those who sing — pray twice. And lately, I have had this song running through my head, “To everything turn, turn, turn, there is a season, turn, turn, turn, and a time to every purpose under heaven.” Sounds like you know it. Written by Pete Seeger in the 1950’s and made popular by the Byrds in 1965, this passage from the Book of Ecclesiastes who understands that there is a season for every experience under heaven;

...a time to be born and a time to die, a time to plant and a time to uproot what is planted...The passage concludes with, “a time to love and a time to hate, a time for war and a time for peace.

Lately, it has seemed that we are in that season of hate, that has emerged from the shadowy periphery, closer to the mainstream than I can ever remember in my lifetime; that we are in a season of moral equivocating, the likes of which I have never seen. I could offer no explanation to my children about how it is possible, that after defeating the Nazis in 1945, that in 2017, Nazis are boldly marching by torchlight through Charlottesville, in a 1930’s style march in our country while spewing vile and hatred towards Jews, and the unmitigated bigotry and hatred of those protestors towards people of color and those who were deemed different. That awful scene that ended in the tragic death of Heather Heyer, the two police officers and the injuries of so many more.

There may be some that are wallowing in this season of hate, but we are here tonight to clearly and loudly proclaim that the time for love and the season for peace is at hand.

To my brothers and sisters of color and those receiving the threats of those who hate — nothing that those who vomit out those views can ever say or do will ever make me hate you. You are safe in my home and in my Temple. If in this strange and troubling time you are in need of Shalom — peace and wholeness, our arms and doors are always open.

I believe with all my heart that when we demonstrate the radical kindness and care that we are capable of showing as creatures made in God’s image, we will genuinely bring about the time of peace Ecclesiastes knows is coming. I refuse to believe that the dark season we might be experiencing must be a permanent feature of our world. There may be dark moments, but never a dark world. The despair creeping into our world will never make me hate; just the opposite. I will love more courageously and care more deeply because that is what America should be all about. Our presence here testifies to this ideal and I beg you to join with me — together — so we can make this place brighter for everyone.

I refuse to believe in America that ennobles the lowest and ugliest of virtues. No one is supreme over another, only the Holy One Above is Supreme. I refuse to hate! I refuse to live in a season of hate. I will love courageously because we are better than the evil that escaped that seeks to divide us.

As Elie Wiesel said, “There may be times when we are powerless to prevent injustices, but there must never be a time when we fail to protest.”

To everything there is a season, and may we, together make sure that the season for love and for peace is now.

## North Korea: Are We Being Told the Truth?

Japan controlled Korea from 1910 until the unconditional surrender documents were signed ending the Asian portion of WWII in 1945. Just days earlier the Soviet Union declared war on Japan and rushed into the northern portion of Korea before the armistice agreement was signed. When the United States suggested a partition at the 38<sup>th</sup> parallel the Russians agreed instantly even though the capital, Seoul was just 35 miles south of the 38<sup>th</sup> parallel.

The influence of the Soviet Union was a critical factor in establishing a communist government in the North with Kim Il-sung as the leader. Since control has followed family lines with his grandson, Kim Jong-un, the current leader. Kim Jong-un was raised along with his generation to detest America. Kim Jong-un wastes his whole life anticipating and preparing for an attack by America. He is the perfect stooge to fall prey from outside influence.

They tell us that as late as April 2016, North Korea tested an engine designed to power an intercontinental ballistic missile (ICBM). On June 23, 2017, North Korea again tested a new rocket engine for an ICBM. Less than two weeks later North Korea launched another ICBM that flew only 37 minutes but we are told it demonstrated the capability of reaching Alaska, Hawaii, or Seattle. The ICBM launched on July, 28, 2017 was even more impressive since Los Angeles, Chicago, and New York City were supposedly within range.

In March 2016, a photo was released of a North Korean war head with the assessment that it was too large to use in the nose of an ICBM. On August 8, 2017 the same photo was released with a proclamation from the

Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA), that North Korea had produced miniaturized warheads for ICBMs. The story of the missile and warhead development is not believable. No technical program as complex as rocket design or warhead development progresses at such a rapid rate. A window into the truth was opened on August 14, 2017 when *The New York Times* revealed the North Korean advancement in missile technology was traced to a Ukrainian company that was a prime source for the Soviet Union missiles during the cold war.

There is an obvious link between Russia, Putin, the Ukrainian company that manufactures missiles, and North Korea that has not appeared in the news or as a statement from any of the U.S. intelligence organizations. Putin has a backdoor deal to stick a finger in Donald Trump using North Korea's young blustering dictator as his puppet.

Notice the similar technique used in the North Korea story and the drip, drip, stories about Hillary Clinton in the 2016 election. A missile story released or rocket fired followed by a pause until the story started to fade from the news, then miraculously there would appear another item of interest.

The published articles were not always success stories but even failures had silver lining. If the rocket had successfully lifted off the launch pad it would have circled the globe.

The next time you see a picture of Putin with a big smile on his face you will know why. He is making fools of North Korea and Kim Jong-un, the United States and Donald Trump all at the same time!

### Tax Reform: Now You See It, Now You Don't!

The Republican's are chomping at the bit, anxious to reform the tax code. Here is what we can expect. The millionaires and billionaires will get the tax repealed that helps support the Affordable Care Act (Obamacare). They couldn't repeal the tax when they failed to repeal the Affordable Care Act but it will be at the top of the priority list on the tax reform agenda. It's a win-win for Republicans. They will cripple Obamacare and give their donors large tax breaks.

If you expect any tax relief, think again. It is far more likely the 77.5 million households who pay no income tax will be required to pay some token amount and programs that result in a negative tax owed and the government sending checks to individuals or families will be repealed. In the past when the government has given the those in the lower tax brackets a tax break, they redefined the bracket so the net result to the taxpayer was little or none. Expect an increase the personal exemption but they will increase the payroll deduction for Social Security or Medicare. The Republican's second priority is to reduce corporate taxes as a thank you to their primary source of campaign funds. They will use the bogus excuse lowering taxes on corporations and small businesses will create jobs. They were wrong about Obamacare destroying jobs and they are just as wrong here. Specifically, they want to reduce or eliminate the income tax on \$2 trillion that corporations are sitting on overseas rather than pay the tax to the U.S. government. They expect us to believe that money will be repatriated, invested in the United States and create jobs here.

Bogus. In 2004, Congress lowered the tax on repatriate money to 5.25 percent, corporations brought back approximately \$312 billion dollars and avoided about \$3.3 billion dollars in taxes. The money was to be used directly for job creation and capital investment and growth opportunities. Not only did the top corporations that repatriated money use the funds to increase dividends to the stockholders, they cut 21,000 jobs in the United States.

Their second bogus excuse is that the United States has one of the highest corporate income tax rates in the world. Your income may fall in a bracket with 39 percent maximum tax rate but that doesn't mean you pay 39 percent income tax. The same is true for corporations. In 2015 the corporate income tax was only 11 percent of the Federal Tax Revenue while payroll taxes were 33 percent and individual income taxes accounted for 47 percent of the total taxes collected. The corporate income tax paid to the United States Government has steadily declined instead of increasing in spite of record profits and record stock prices. <https://taxfoundation.org/repatriation-tax-holiday-hangover>

They will never get a serious effort to refine the tax code off the ground. They will never agree on what they are trying to accomplish. They will quibble over whether people that will owe little or no income tax should fill out a full page document, 1040 form, or a postcard. They will spend months worrying about whether any little change will affect their re-election. The result will be a huge corporate welfare program!

### **This Again...Rockwall Polling Locations In Rowlett Are At Risk For Closure.**

The Voting Rights Act of 1964, Section 2 states:

No voting qualification or prerequisite to voting, or standard, practice, or procedure shall be imposed or applied by any State or political subdivision to deny or abridge the right of any citizen of the United States to vote on account of race or color.

Many states, including Texas, have passed and implemented laws that make it harder for Americans to vote — restrictions are often tailor-made to disenfranchise people of color and low-income voters. These voter suppression efforts have had a massive effect, depressing turnout in the last two elections. This past week the Texas Voter ID law was again struck down by a Federal Court.

Since the election of Donald Trump, his followers have ramped up the attack on black and brown people. White supremacy is on the rise. Voting is our most powerful weapon to fight bigotry and racially-motivated violence like that which occurred in Charlottesville. We should never normalize bigotry and racism.

We must use our Democracy to fight back against attempts to deny people their voting rights. Only Elections can end racist Policies and stop the shrinkage of voting rights in communities of color and for young voters. County Elections officials and commissioners should be working to expand the opportunities for people to vote not contract them.

Rockwall County has two voting precincts in Rowlett. Precincts 1A has traditionally voted at Cullins Lakepointe Elementary and 2B has voted at several locations due to the renovations at Lakepointe Hospital, and the tornado damage to Rowlett Health and Rehabilitation Center.

Currently, Rockwall County Commissioners are considering closing these two precincts and having Rockwall voters from Rowlett vote at the Rockwall County Library in the November 7, 2017 Constitutional Amendment Election. The Election Administrator's recommendation cites low voter turnout in Rowlett and costs to the County. My concern is that this will make it more difficult for Rockwall County voters living in Rowlett to vote.

In the previous attempt to close these precincts, the people spoke. The precincts remained open. Time to make our voices heard, again Contact Rockwall County officials and let them know that Precincts 1A and 2B must remain open.

## GOVERNOR WHITE REMEMBERED



**Governor White 1940 - 2017**

Governor Mark White championed public education reforms that helped end his political career. The former governor, who fought kidney cancer for years, died August 5, 2017 in Houston shortly after waking up and feeling uncomfortable. He was 77.

White was governor from 1983 until 1987. The education policies approved during his single term included pay raises and competency tests for teachers, class size limits for elementary schools and the state's high school basic skills graduation test.

White also pushed through a \$4 billion tax increase to help pay for schools and highways. The no-pass, no-play legislation was an unpopular move that had to survive a challenge at the state Supreme Court.

In a recent interview with *The Houston Chronicle*, Mr. White lamented the hyperpartisanship that has come to define both state and national politics. "It's like combat now," he said. "But," he added, "I never give up on this state, on this country. That's what you learn after being in politics as long as I have. If you give up, then you're part of the problem."

Telephone messages will not suffice to give written notice. Please share this with any of your family or friends who have been affected by Hurricane Harvey.**



### How to Help — This is only a few ways!
