Colin Allred, TX32-D Working For US

The first question an incumbent hoping to be re-elected must be asked is: “What have you accomplished in your previous term?” Representative Colin Allred, TX32-D can answer this question. In his initial term in the U.S. Congress, Allred voted for both articles of impeachment against Donald J. Trump, served on the Committee on Foreign Affairs, the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and the Subcommittee on Disability Assistance for veterans and is a member of the Congressional Black Caucus and the New Democratic Coalition.

Service to Veterans is Service for America

The highlight of Rep. Allred’s first term may be the greatest accomplishment of his tenure in the House no matter how many years he serves. Allred worked with a group that convinced Baylor Scott & White Health and Tenet Healthcare to donate the vacant Baylor Scott & White Hospital for use as a veterans hospital in Garland, Texas.

Allred noted: “In the long term, this is a huge victory for our veterans and the city of Garland.” The hospital opened with 100 beds to begin treating veterans infected with COVID-19.” Allred’s office added, the facility will provide outpatient services and serve as a specialty care clinic for the roughly 184,000 veterans who live in North Texas. The 470,000 square foot facility may eventually create 5,000 jobs according to the Dallas VA.

Allred’s concern for veteran’s care goes beyond the building. He introduced a bill to restore the 48 hour review to identify technical mistakes and errors in that can affect veteran’s benefits. Allred helped introduce a bill to re-authorize a bill to allow veterans to assist their fellow veterans with accessing the benefits and services they earned. Allred and others pressured the VA to reduce its 125,000 claim backlog. Allred introduced a bill to help veterans and care givers pay for personal protective equipment.

20th Amendment U.S. Constitution

Section 1:

The terms of the President and the Vice President shall end at noon on the 20th day of January, and the terms of Senators and Representatives at noon on the 3d day of January, of the years in which such terms would have ended if this article had not been ratified; and the terms of their successors shall then begin.

Section 2:

The Congress shall assemble at least once in every year, and such meeting shall begin at noon on the 3d day of January, unless they shall by law appoint a different day.

Section 3

If, at the time fixed for the beginning of the term of the President, the President elect shall have died, the Vice President elect shall become President. If a President shall not have been chosen before the time fixed for the beginning of his term, or if the President elect shall have failed to qualify, then the Vice President elect shall act as President until a President shall have qualified; and the Congress may by law provide for the case wherein neither a President elect nor a Vice President shall have qualified, declaring who shall then act as President, or the manner in which one who is to act shall be selected, and such person shall act accordingly until a President or Vice President shall have qualified.

Section 4:

The Congress may by law provide for the case of the death of any of the persons from whom the House of Representatives may choose a President whenever the right of choice shall have devolved upon them, and for the case of the death of any of the persons from whom the Senate may choose a Vice President whenever the right of choice shall have devolved upon them.

Section 5:

Sections 1 and 2 shall take effect on the 15th day of October following the ratification of this article.

Section 6: This article shall be inoperative unless it shall have been ratified as an amendment to the Constitution by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several States within seven years from the date of its submission.

Laurence Tribe explains the constitutional 'fail-safe' — that could result in President Nancy Pelosi

Constitutional law expert Laurence Tribe was interviewed on Friday by MSNBC's Joy Reid on "The ReidOut."

Tribe, who has taught at Harvard Law for fifty years and argued dozens of cases before the U.S. Supreme Court offered an intriguing theory Reid suggested had cheered up many of her viewers.

Reid asked Tribe about President Donald Trump talking about trying to delay the November election as he trails former Vice President Joe Biden in the polls.

"They're trying to make it look chaotic but there's a fail-safe mechanism built into the constitution itself," Tribe said. "No matter how much dust he throws into the gears, at high noon on January 20th, 2021, if there has not been a new president elected, at that point, Nancy Pelosi, Speaker of the House become president of the United States."

Tribe explained that "all of the enablers at that point would risk committing federal felonies if they were to exercise power, which they no longer have, because Trump would no longer be president."

"That's the fail-safe. The constitution is not designed to self-destruct but it's designed to self-preserve," he explained.

"There's every reason to believe that the new Congress is going to be in Democratic hands. So I wouldn't, at this point, play Trump's game of throwing up our hands and saying 'there will be no winner, Trump is going to win by default.' He can't really do it,"

Tribe noted. "The default solution in our system is President Nancy Pelosi — and I can think of worse

"There's been a lot of pontificating about what happens if the election is cancelled or even postponed by more than six weeks or so (which prevents Electors from being certified in time). Of course, this isn't going to happen, for many reasons. But let's indulge the fantasy and figure it out; it's a lot more complicated and interesting than you would guess.

First, Trump and Pence go away on January 20, 2021, because their terms end under the 20th Amendment. But that doesn't mean Nancy Pelosi becomes President, because her term, along with every other member of the House, ends on January 3, 2021. There is no speaker because there is no House of Representatives. (This is Reason #1 why they won't allow the election to be postponed.)

Next in line is President Pro Tempore of the Senate, which is currently Chuck Grassley. But he doesn't become President, either, because on January 3, 2021, all the Senate seats up for election become vacant. This leaves a Senate of 66 members, and a DEMOCRATIC majority. 

Virus Spread Reality

More than 200 scientists have called for the World Health Organization and others to acknowledge that the coronavirus can spread in the air — a change that could alter some of the current measures being taken to stop the pandemic.

In a letter published this week in the journal Clinical Infectious Diseases, two scientists from Australia and the U.S. wrote that studies have shown “beyond any reasonable doubt that viruses are released during exhalation, talking and coughing in microdroplets small enough to remain aloft in the air.” That means people in certain indoor conditions could be at greater risk of being infected than was previously thought.

The WHO has long maintained that COVID-19 is spread via larger respiratory droplets, most often when people cough or sneeze, that fall to the ground. It has dismissed the possibility of airborne transmission, except for certain high-risk medical procedures, like when patients are first put on breathing machines.

This could be a game-changer when thinking of to mask or not and how safe we might be with family members not living in the same household.

There is an immutable truth that if we do not learn from the past we are condemned to repeat it.


Madison's Note on the Federal Convention answers two questions: 1) the character of our union and 2) the status of the chief executive.
